

Football Rankings and Eligibility

- All AA and AAA schools must play 10 games to qualify for play-offs. Three D-5 AA schools will qualify through D-6
- All class A schools must play 9 games to qualify for play-offs. The 12 top ranked class A schools will be determined, with no lower ranked replacements. Byes will be issued for the four highest ranked schools.
- All wins ending on the 10th week will count for opponents playing AA and AAA schools, including class A first round play-offs.

Week Class A 9 game minimum

- 10 Top ranked 12 teams of 23 will qualify. Teams 1, 2, 3, 4 Bye
All first round games will be played on Friday (exception: no lights play Sat)
- 11 1 vs. 8 and 2 vs. 7 ranked teams play on Friday

Week Class AA 10 game minimum

- 11 Top ranked 8 teams of 16 (incl. 3 D-5 teams) will qualify
- 12 1 vs. 8 and 2 vs. 7 ranked teams play on Friday

Week Class AAA 10 game minimum

- 11 Top ranked 2 teams will qualify to play for the D-6 championship
- 12 D-6 champion will play D-9 champion
- 13 The D6-9 winner will play D-4

Week Class AAAA 10 game minimum

- 11 All four teams will be eligible
- 12 Top two teams will play for regional title
- 13 D-6, 9,10 champ will play D-8
